


















THE SEA-EU VISION



Only 284 universities of Europe participate in the programme (5% of the total).

EC would like to double this figure in the coming 5 years to achieve 10%, by:

- Launching more alliances
- Increasing the number of partners per Alliance (recommendation of 9 partners/alliance)

95% of Universities in Europe are willing to enter an Alliance

The alliances of the first call (as SEA-EU) ends in September 2022

The European Commission (EC) wants to consolidate this programme EUI

EC propose to extend the funding for a period of 4+2 years (after evaluation of results)






